When: Tuesday May 28, 2024, at 5 P.M. – 6 P.M.

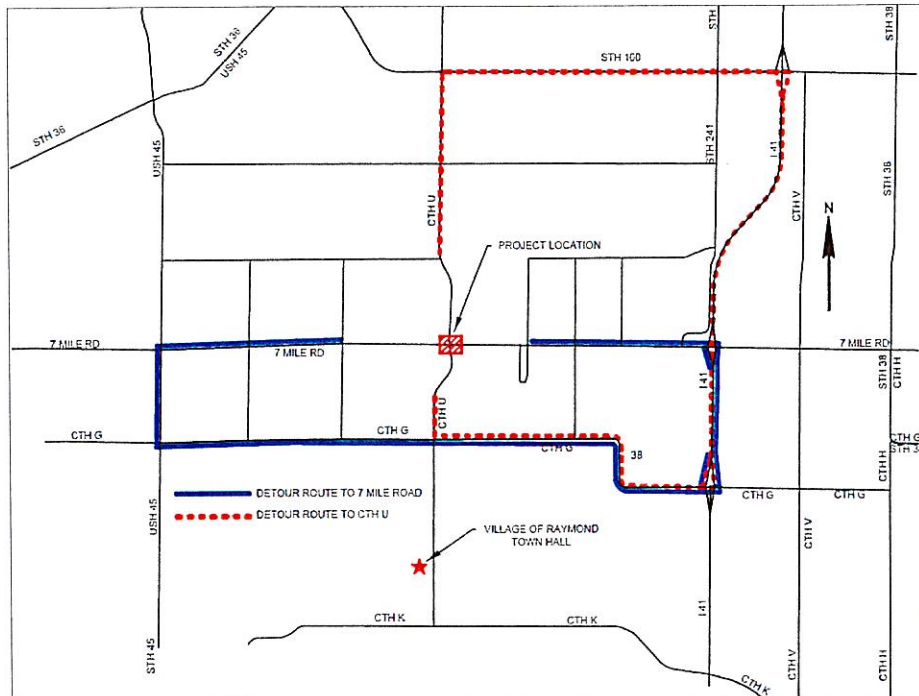


Figure 1: Project Location, Public Information Meeting Location, and Detour Routes

Road work will begin this summer to improve the intersection of County U with 7 Mile Road in the Village of Raymond, Racine County. Improvements will include a new one lane asphalt pavement roundabout, concrete median islands, storm sewer, new street lighting, permanent signing and pavement marking. Construction will start in early June and the road will be completely closed to through traffic for the duration of the project, with a detour to be posted. The project will be completed, and the road reopened in late August.
