3. Discussion/decision regarding WE Energies street lighting associated with the Hwy U and Hwy G roundabout;

Motion to post job listing for a DPW maintenance worker on a Schwartz/Thelen motion. Motion carried 5-0.

7. Motion to adjourn a Thelen/Wilson motion. Meeting adjourned at 7:36 pm.
