

**VILLAGE BOARD - VILLAGE OF RAYMOND, WI
SPECIAL MEETING – DECEMBER 9, 2025**

The Raymond Village Board held a Special Meeting on Tuesday, December 9, 2025, at 5:00 PM, at the Raymond Village Hall, 2255-76th Street, Franksville, WI 53126.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm by President Doug White.

On roll call. President White, Trustees Doug Schwartz, Mike Thelen, and Keith Kastenson were present. Trustee Gelhaus was absent.

Discussion/Decision regarding directing the Village Attorney to draft an agreement ending the Raymond-Caledonia border agreement to include a provision for a future sewer connection at Caledonia's expense;

Concerns were raised that Raymond should not be financially responsible and that Raymond is not obligated if they cannot hook up to sewer. There were also concerns regarding a conflict of interest with Foth engineers. These concerns should be expressed to the attorney.

Motion to have the Village Attorney draft an agreement to end the border agreement with Caledonia and draw up a provision for a sewer connection at Caledonia's expense on Schwartz/Kastenson motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion to move to closed session at 5:08 pm on a Kastenson/Thelen motion.

Move to Closed Session pursuant to State Statute 19.85(1)(c) Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility: Discuss DPW interviews with potential offer to hire;

Motion to move to open session at 5:20 pm on a Kastenson/Thelen motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Possible Decision regarding closed session item

Motion to offer Brad V. the DPW position and give him until 12:00 pm on Friday, December 12th to accept the offer of hire, and if he declined to offer the position to Bryan I. on a Schwartz/Thelen motion. Motion carried 4-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:23 pm on a Kastenson/Thelen motion. Motion carried 4-0.
