RESOLUTION 26-3-23

RESOLUTION RESCINDING COOPERATIVE BOUNDARY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Raymond (“Raymond”) and the Village of Caledonia (“Caledonia”) entered a Cooperative Boundary Plan (“CBP”) pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. §66.0307 approved by the Wisconsin Department of Administration in; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the CBP was to address annexation, extraterritorial zoning and platting and development issues within the former Town of Raymond; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Raymond incorporated as a Village in 2019; and

WHEREAS, Raymond and Caledonia have determined that the underlying purposes of the CBP are no longer necessary or germane the current circumstances related to the municipalities.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Raymond:

The Raymond/Caledonia Cooperative Boundary Plan is hereby rescinded, effective upon the following:

1. Adoption by the Village of Caledonia of a Resolution Rescinding the Cooperative Boundary Plan.
 2. Publication of a Notice of the proposed Rescission pursuant to the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. § 66.0307(4)(a) by both Villages by Class 3 notice pursuant to Ch. 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes, that the proposed Rescission will be submitted directly to the Department of Administration unless written objection to the amendment is received by the municipality within seven days after publication of the last required notice.
 3. If no written objection to the amendment is received within seven days after publication of the last required notice, the proposed rescission shall be submitted directly to the Department of Administration for approval.
 4. Upon approval of the rescission by the Department of Administration, the Cooperative Boundary plan shall be rescinded and of no further force and effect.
